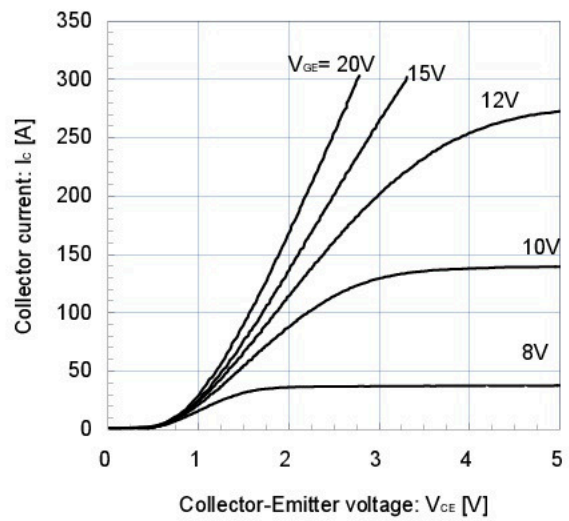

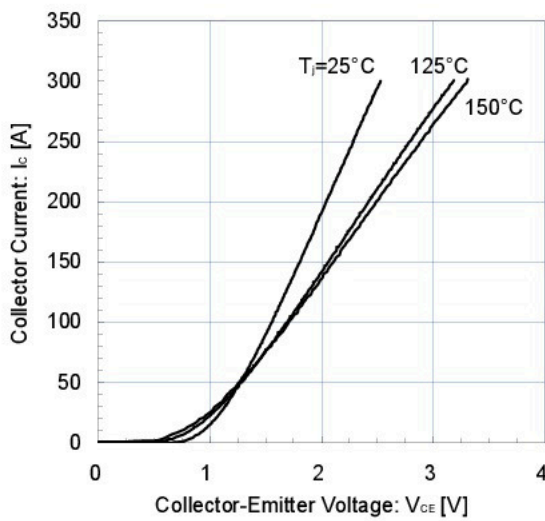
Collector current vs. Collector-Emittter voltage (typ.)
 $T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}$ / chip



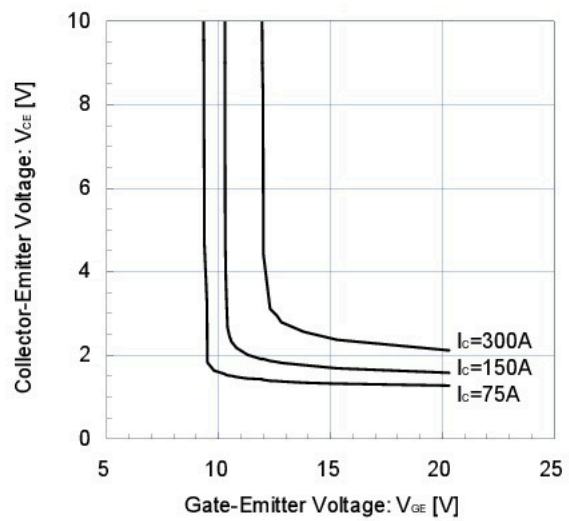
Collector current vs. Collector-Emittter voltage (typ.)
 $T_j = 150^\circ\text{C}$ / chip



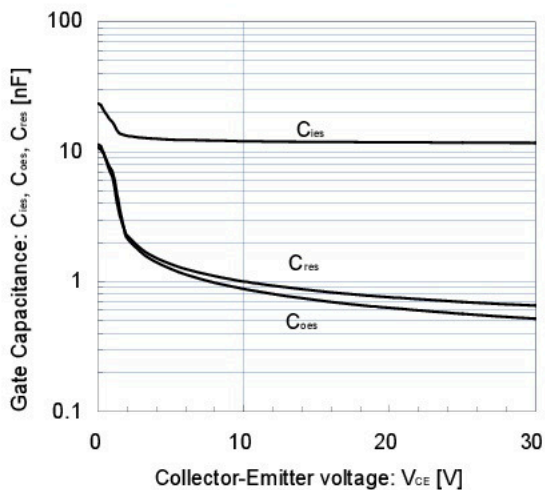
Collector current vs. Collector-Emittter voltage (typ.)
 $V_{ge} = 15\text{V}$ / chip



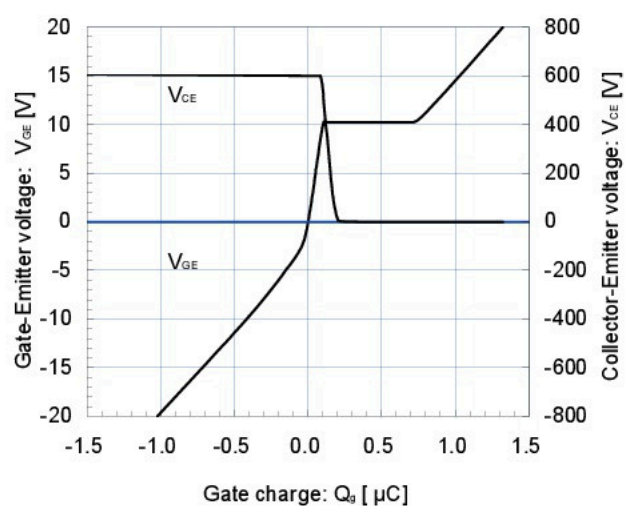
Collector-Emittter voltage vs. Gate-Emittter voltage
 $T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}$ / chip



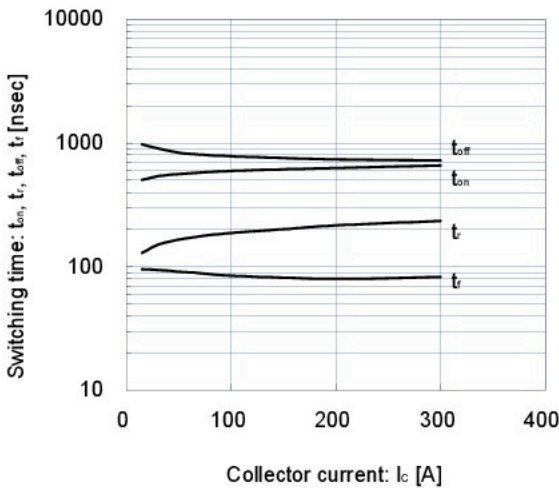
Gate Capacitance vs. Collector-Emittter Voltage

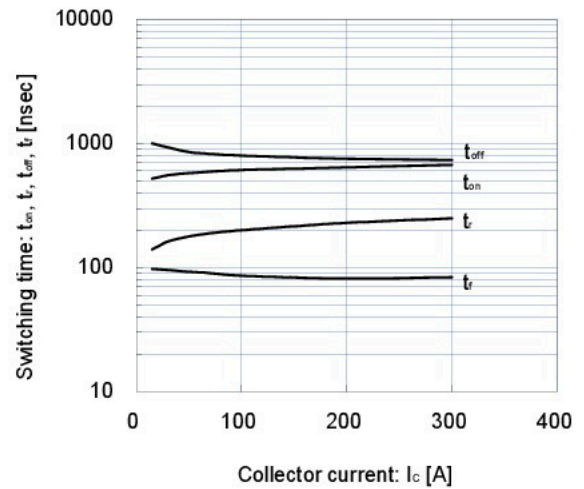
Dynamic Gate Charge (typ.)

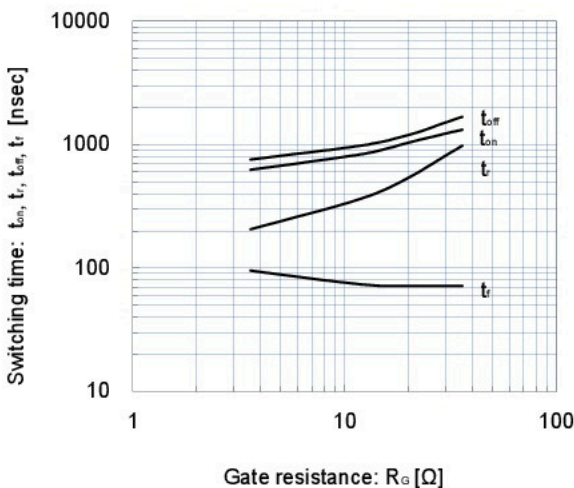
Switching time vs. Collector current (typ.)

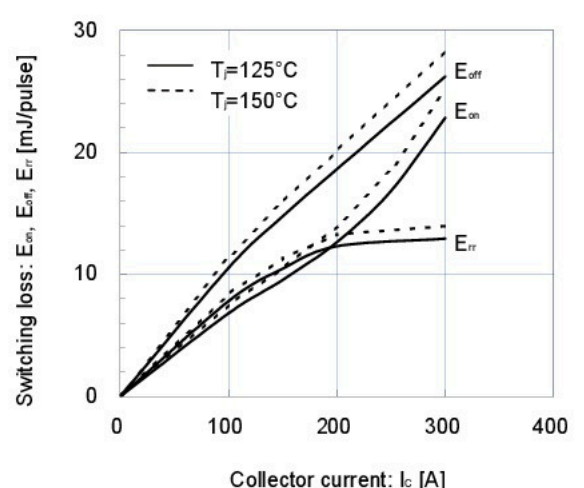
Switching time vs. Collector current (typ.)

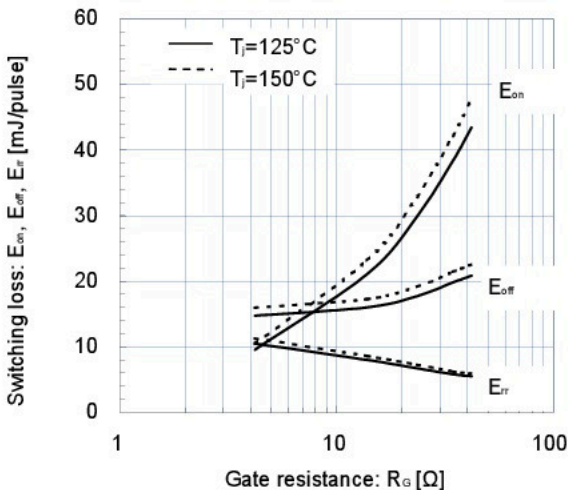
Switching time vs. Gate resistance (typ.)

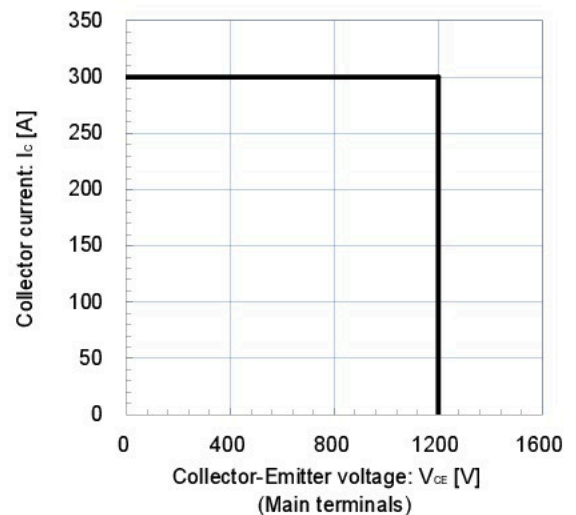
Switching loss vs. Collector current (typ.)
 $V_{CC}=600, V_{GE}=\pm 15V, R_G=4.2\Omega, T_J=125, 150^\circ C$



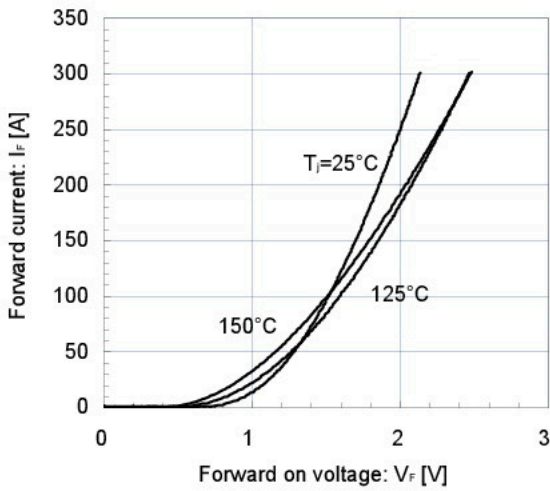
Switching loss vs. Gate resistance (typ.)

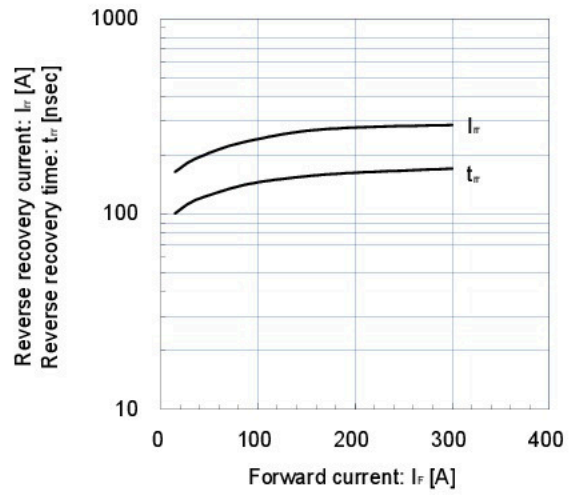
Reverse bias safe operating area (max.)

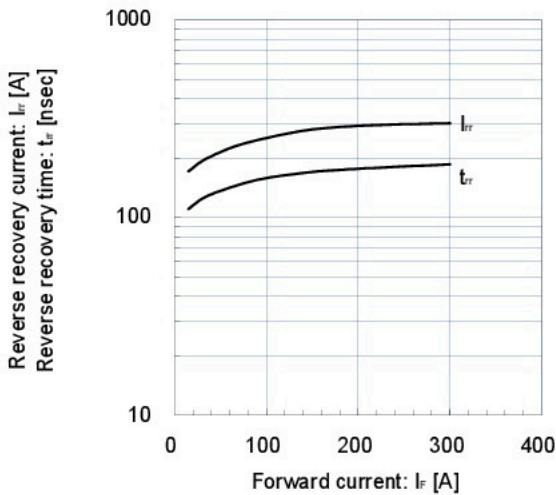
Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage (typ.)

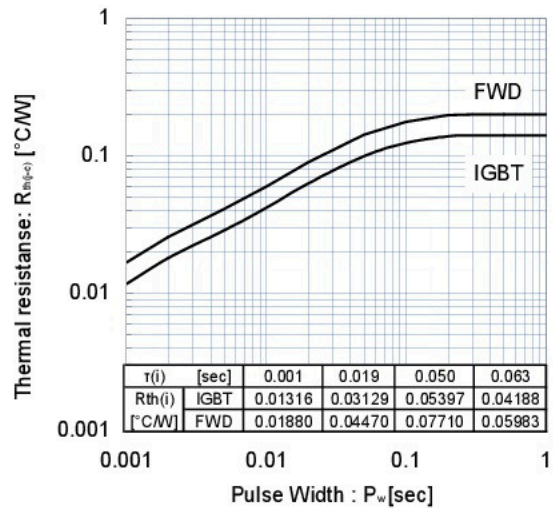
Reverse Recovery Characteristics (typ.)
 $V_{CC}=600V, V_{GE}=\pm 15V, R_G=4.2\Omega, T_j=125^\circ C$



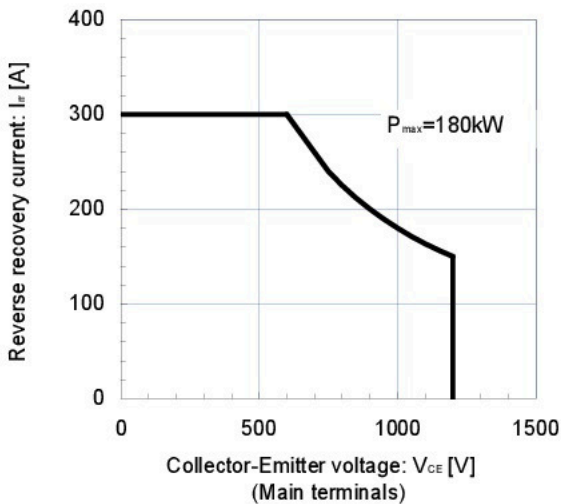
Reverse Recovery Characteristics (typ.)
 $V_{CC}=600V, V_{GE}=\pm 15V, R_G=4.2\Omega, T_j=150^\circ C$



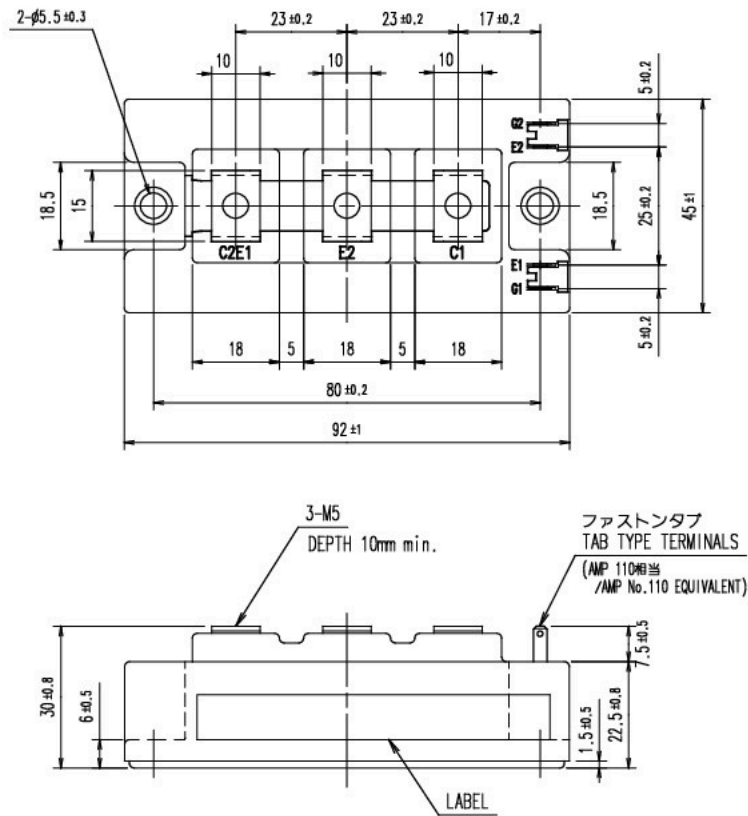
Transient Thermal Resistance (max.)

 $T_j=150^\circ C$

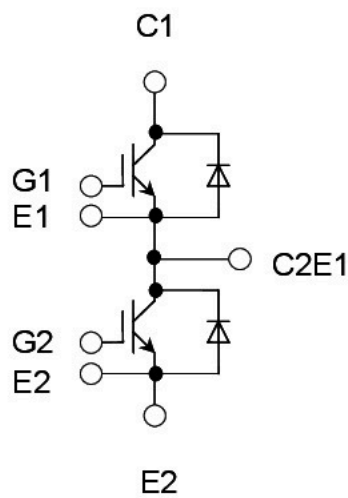
